

STEP ONE **LOOK AT IRELAND**

Today is the right time to establish new, vibrant and healthy churches in the north and south of Ireland. Modern Ireland is fertile ground for a message of faith, hope and love through Jesus Christ.

Across country there is, 'a very active and growing church which is appealing to people of all ages and backgrounds and which is highly representative of the multi-ethnic and multi-cultural Ireland of today.

Almost 60% of churches reported either some or significant growth with almost 90% expecting to experience growth over the next five years.

In terms of church members, 46% are under 30 years of age, while 75% are under 50 years of age and the majority of churches display a significant commitment to developing faith, prayer, evangelism and community outreach.'

STEP TWO

Church planting is still the most effective means for advancing the gospel locally, regionally and around the world.....but it's really hard work! That's why church planters with Advance will take intentional time to listen.

We've highlighted several people church planters need to listen to:

Listen to God

Church planting is primarily about working in partnership with Jesus who, through the Holy Spirit, promises to build His Church in local communities around the world.

The New Testament has plenty to encourage us about the local church, and God has plenty to say to potential church planters. Church planters will be listening to God as He begins to stir faith to birth something new.

Moreover, God, slowly but surely, impresses particular locations. Impressions gives way to conviction, creating an unshakeable brokenness for a certain community. Such passion is coupled with a certainty that the gospel of Jesus Christ is the only hope for societal transformation.

The bible comes alive in fresh ways in the hands of the emerging church planter. The Holy Spirit illuminates the Divine narrative, amplifying words of calling and confirmation.

Persistent impression, conviction and illumination - potential church planters will lean in and listen to God.

Listen to peers, pastors and planters

The bible is packed with great advice to make sure to gather great advice! What about....

"...in an abundance of counsellors, there is safety,"
Proverbs 11 v 14

Or....

'Listen to advice and accept instruction, that you may gain wisdom in the future,' Proverbs 19 v 20

Whether a church leader, pastor, ministry team member or potential church planter, we never grow out of our need to gather wise counsel.

That's why listening is such a key step when you plant a church with Advance through CCI.

Start with trusted friends and family, usually your spouse since planting a church is likely to impact your immediate family the most. From there, widen your 'counsel' net and talk with people you trust and who are not afraid to be honest with - and about - you.

The next door to knock is your current spiritual leader. They are someone who knows you well, has seen you use your gifts in the local church and will have valuable insight into your readiness to plant a church. Further, your pastor is likely to know a thing or two about leading a church and as such will be a valuable resource of 'wisdom in the future.' More than that, its likely your pastor, along with a dedicated team, planted your church, so make sure you reach out and pay for the coffee!

From there, the most obvious people to talk to are church planters. These are people who have began a new church within the past one to five years and we would encourage you to invite them to be candid about their experience. While there are many sweet, Divine high points in launching a new church, church planters will have experienced their fair share of low moments too. As a potential planter, it's really important to learn about both.

If, by the end of all the prayers, Scriptures and coffees, you have green lights all the way, it's time for...

The Application

The more formal part of church planting with Advance starts here - with the application.

The application form is accessed from www.advancewithcci.ie filled out online and emailed to the address shown.

The application is a multi-part document, nine pages long and is the place where we ask for more information about your:

- family
- employment
- finance
- training
- sending church
- potential church
- experience
- beliefs
- why Advance?
- references......

The Interview

After a successful review of your application form, you and your spouse, if applicable, will be invited to meet with the Advance Lead Team for an interview.


This time together will focus more deeply on the information submitted on your application but the Advance Lead Team are also keen to hear what's in your heart for the Church, the church you'd love to plant and the community in which you wish to plant it.

After the interview the Lead Team will request a little more information from the references you supplied and taken together with the application and the interview the Advance Lead Team will make their decision whether to proceed to the next step or to defer taking the next step until personal or professional conditions develop.





The course comprises of -




You're already a local church leader, with a dedicated team of committed leaders ready to do whatever it takes to reach your community.

CHURCH RENEWAL WHAT'S THE PROCESS?

Church Renewal - the process is exactly the same as planting a new church.

Step #1 - Look: consider deeply and define clearly the VISION you believe God has for your church and its community. Does the vision stir you and your team? Does the vision stimulate desire for a preferred future for your immediate world? Does the vision activate sacrificial momentum and creativity within you and your team?

Step #2 - Listen: take time to listen to God, to peers and to pastors close to you. Critically analyse their feedback, paying particular attention to their comments around vision and the future.

Step #3 - Let's GO: Vision, prayer, passion and feedback seem to create the confidence to take the next step = to apply for Church Renewal with Advance and CCI. After the application comes the interview where you will meet with the Advance Lead Team...

This time together will focus more deeply on the information submitted on your application but the Advance Lead Team are also keen to hear what's in your heart for the Church, the church you believe you can become, what you understand to have been the circumstances which have led to the current condition of the church and the steps you and the leadership will take to ensure the church is best placed to thrive.

After the interview the Lead Team will request a little more information from the references you supplied and taken together with the application and the interview the Advance Lead Team will make their decision whether to proceed to the next step or to defer taking the next step until personal or professional conditions develop.

Step #4 - Learn: the first step at this stage is a full audit of your existing church undertaken by a member, or members, of the Advance Lead Team. The audit is likely to take some time and will comprise of site visits to your church on Sunday's as well as attending Leadership team meetings and

extensive interviews with you and your leadership team, together and separately.

Upon the findings of the audit, the Advance Lead Team will report back to you and your leadership team and recommend a course of action that's consistent with its findings. Such recommendations may include enrolling with the Church Planting stream or the Diploma in Ministry and Leadership with the Academy, attend ARC training events and/or begin to integrate more fully into the heart of the movement to deepen relationships. You'll also become familiar with ways to fundraise for your church renewal. Your church will be assigned an Advance Team mentor for twelve months.

It's worth noting however the audit findings may recommend that Advance not support a church renewal at this time. If this is the case, the Advance Lead Team will liaise with you and the leadership team about possible next steps.

Step #5 - Launch: or perhaps re - launch! You've come through the audit, training and fundraising. You have a strong, compelling vision and a passionate team that's ready for the future. Now it's time to relaunch your church into its community.

Step #6 - Lead: You'll know by now CCI exists to strengthen your local church, to support the vision God has shared with you, helping to establish leaders and teams and crucially, being a constant source of support and encouragement for the journey no matter what lies ahead.

Renewing your church with Advance means your church is already a 'partner church' within the Christian Churches Ireland network, allowing you to avail of all the benefits partnership offers.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can a non-CCI church plant a new church with Advance?

Yes, and every church that plants with Christian Churches Ireland automatically becomes part of our highly relational, autonomous network of local churches across Ireland.

Can existing, healthy, CCI churches plant with Advance?

Yes. We are a missional movement with a desire to see a healthy local church in every community. This means existing CCI churches can apply to plant a church with Advance and avail of the Look2Lead planting process including access to match funding and year one budget support.

If I plant with Advance through CCI will I become an ARC Ireland church too?

If you successfully apply to plant a church with Advance through CCI, you will have the opportunity to apply separately to ARC Ireland and avail of their training and match funding. If successful, your church will become part of the ARC Ireland church planting network for the amount of time your church pays forward the funding loan. Your church can of course choose to remain in and support the training work of ARC in Ireland after the loan has been repaid.

Our church is a step away from closing. Can I apply for Church Renewal with Advance?

Yes, and our extensive audit will seek to discover and embed fresh ministry philosophies, practical systems and relevant training to ensure your church continues to remain increasingly loyal to its future rather than its past.
