

GARDA VETTING AND THE CCI CHURCH

- Every church must have a Child Protection Officer (CPO), who manages all areas of children's protection in your church.
- It is the responsibility of the church's CPO to ensure that every person in the church, age 16 and over who volunteers in any capacity directly linked to children/youth/vulnerable persons must be Garda Vetted.
- Everyone in the church who holds ministerial credentials with CCI must be Garda Vetted, irrespective of whether or not they are involved with children/youth/vulnerable persons.
- These people must be Garda Vetted <u>BEFORE</u> they take up any voluntary work.

The process for Garda Vetting is:

- 1) started by filling in a paper Garda Vetting Invitation Form NCB1
- 2) *continued* by filling in the online Garda eVetting Form that is sent to each applicant.
- 3) *completed* upon the receipt of a Garda Vetting Certificate from the Vetting Bureau. This certifies that the person is approved to work with children/youth/vulnerable persons.
- These forms need to be renewed every 3 years.
