

# CCI CHURCH GARDA VETTING PROCEDURE

#### WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

#### 1) **GET THE FORM**:

The church's Child Protection Office (CPO) needs to provide all those working with children/youth/vulnerable persons in the church with the Garda Vetting Invitation Form (NVB1\*\*) **before** they start to work.

# 2) **COMPLETE THE FORM:**

Volunteers being vetted need to complete the paper form. **Completing this form is not the Garda vetting**, it is merely a data gathering document, that must be accompanied by:

- a) a copy proof of address (dated within the last 6 months)
- b) proof of identity (passport, driver's licence etc).

If a volunteer is 16–17 years, they must supply a parental declaration of consent - NVB3 form\*\*.

# 3) PAY:

The Garda Vetting Bureau charge a **fee of €10** to process each application. Please pay via the "Give" button on <a href="www.ccireland.ie">www.ccireland.ie</a> or by bank transfer to the CCI Bank. Include payment ref: applicant's name/s, garda vetting.

## 4) SEND IN THE FORM AND ID:

The CPO:

- a) collects the completed form and the 2 proofs of ID from the volunteer
- **b) signs** the copy of the ID to confirm identity
- c) posts them to

Garda Vetting, CCI Office, St Marks Church, 42a Pearse St, Dublin D02 R123.

Once the CCI team have received the fee payment & the documentation, they will submit the vetting application to the National Youth Council of Ireland (NYCI).

## 5) FILL IN THE ONLINE APPLICATION:

The NYCI will set up a garda vetting on-line link, that will be e-mailed to each applicant. \*Upon the receipt of this e-mail, the vetting applicant must fill in all data required & submit.\*

Once the application is successful, the CCI team will e-mail the certificate (disclosure) to the CPO and applicant.
